Transition Plan

Any application in which the Authority received 1st submission and provided comments prior to January 1st, 2023, will continue to be reviewed in the context of our current Memorandum of Understandings up to April 28, 2023. At this point, the Authority will no longer provide review and comments on natural heritage issues for these transition development applications. This review requirement will fully revert to the approval authority at this time.

Any application received after January 1st or any application that did not get reviewed by the Authority prior to January 1st, 2023, will be reviewed in the context of the current legislation.
